

WATER POLICY TASK FORCE MINUTES (WPTF)
Metropolitan Commission Conference Room
Minutes of September 28, 2010

WPTF Members present were Barne Wheeler, Chairman; David Kelsey; Sheryl Skrabacz, SMHD; Cannon Morse, PNAS; and, Charles Downs. Members absent: Jacki Meiser, MetCom, Bill Shreve

1. **Call to Order:** The meeting was called to order at 6:05 p.m.
2. **Discussion & Approval of Meeting Minutes:** The July 2010 Meeting Minutes were approved as written.
3. **Continuing Business:**
 - 3.1. **Gray Water Initiative.** Mr. Kelsey indicated that since gray water was not approved for use inside the home, much of the rationale for undertaking the initiative was gone. He recommended that our report to the commissioners emphasize the importance that greater use of gray water could have in conserving the county's water supplies.
 - 3.2. **Private Well Usage Data from Charles County.** Mr. Shreve was not present, so no additional data from Charles County was available.
 - 3.3. **Comprehensive Plan Water Conservation Discussion.**
 - 3.3.1. **Conservation Spreadsheet.** The group refined the information contained in the spreadsheet which would be used to calculate estimated water savings in various categories. Mr. Wheeler said he would incorporate the information into a revised spreadsheet.
 - 3.3.2. **Presentation Slides.** Mr. Wheeler indicated that he was still working on updating the BOCC presentation and would have a more complete version the next time the WPTF met.

5. **Announcements:** The group agreed that a meeting in January was the most appropriate. It was also agreed that we should not attempt to get on the Commissioners agenda before late April or May to allow the new BOCC members to get themselves oriented.
